He showed beautiful pictures during his expedition in 2020. He was one of the fellow scientists who the Indian Government sent for the zone monitoring expedition.

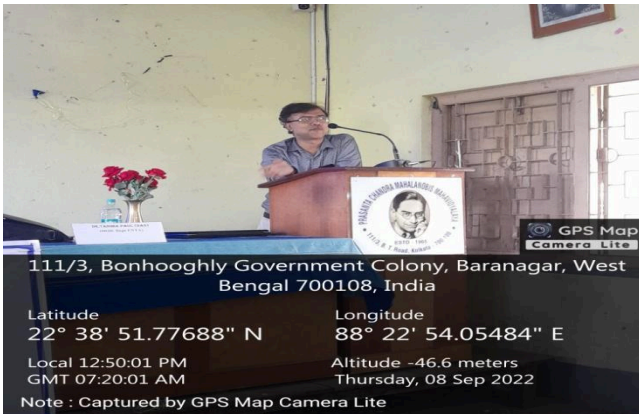
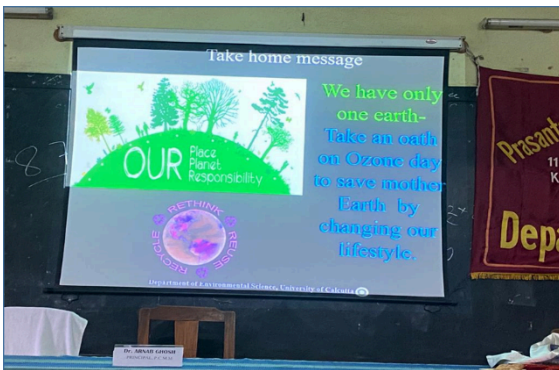
