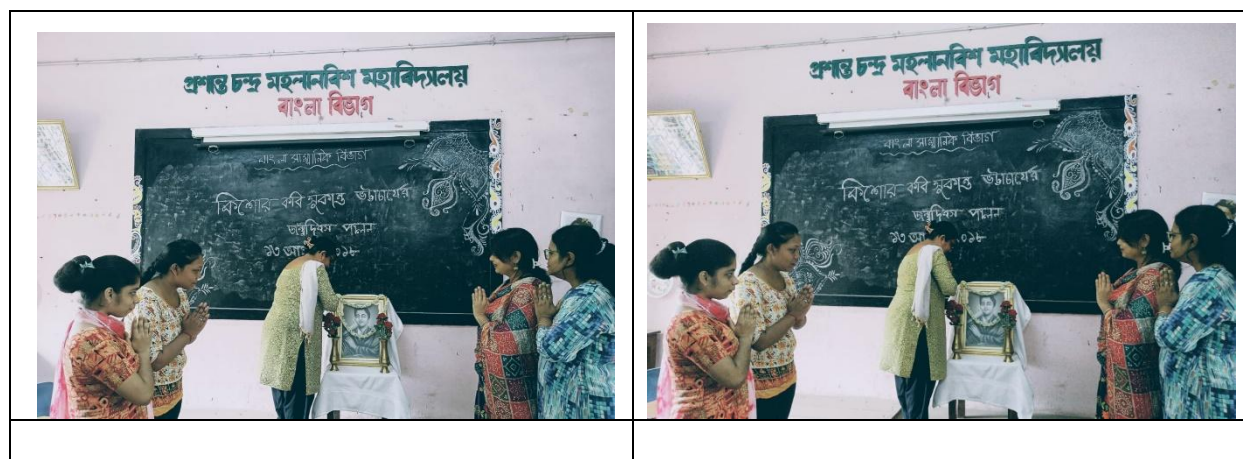




College Cultural Competition
