## **BANOMAHATSAB -07.07.2019**

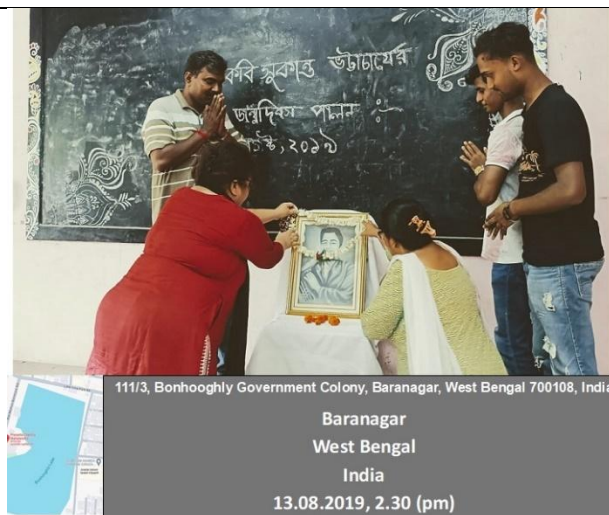

## CULTURAL PROGRAMME ON TEACHER'S DAY- 05.09.2019

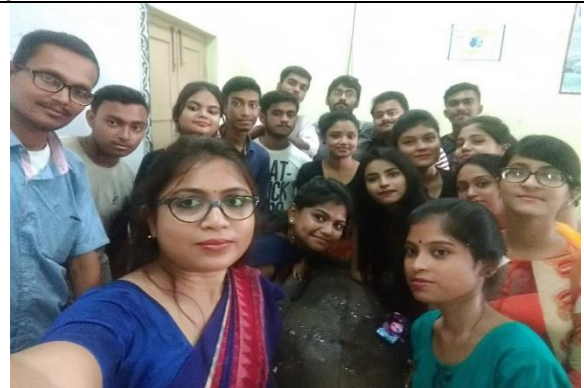

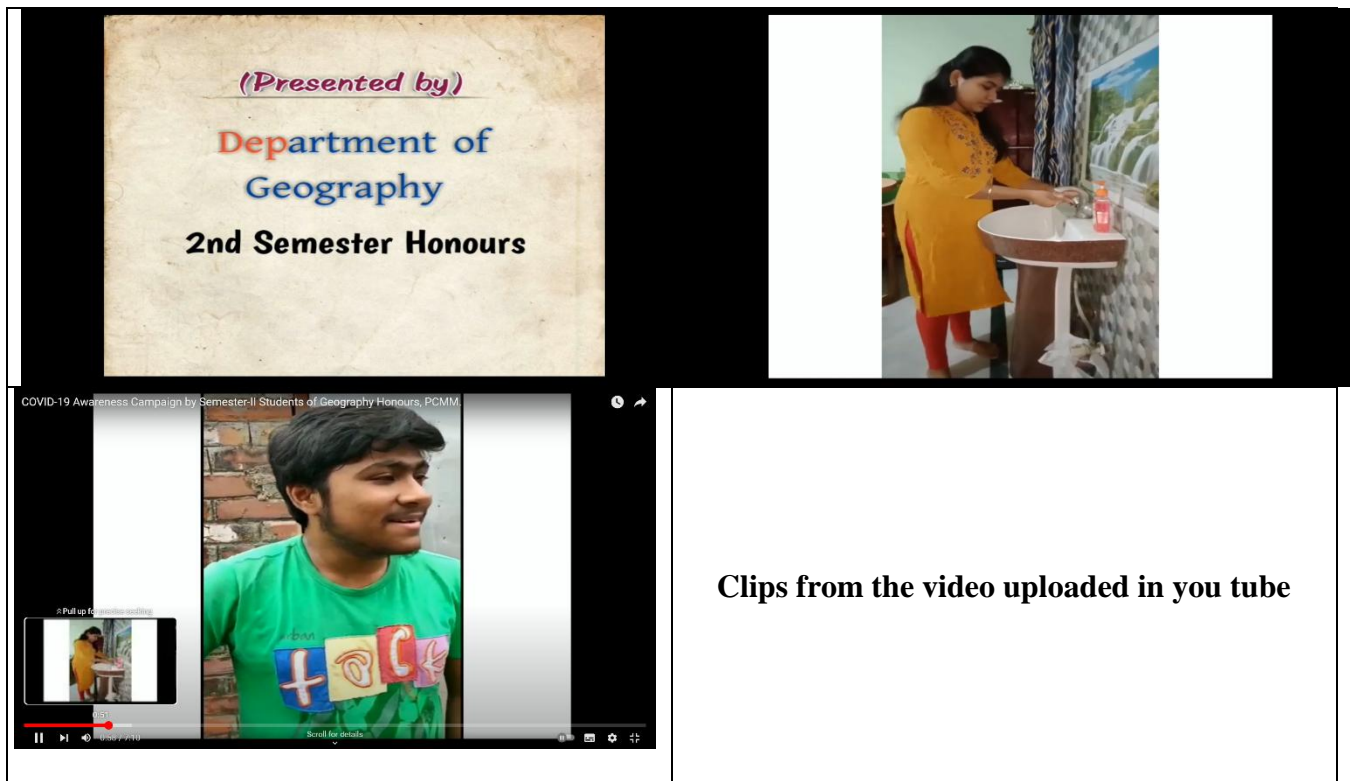
