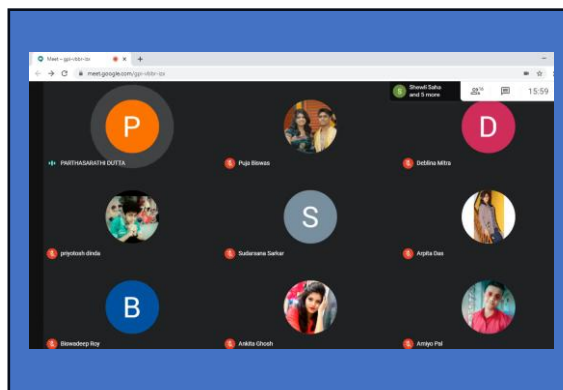
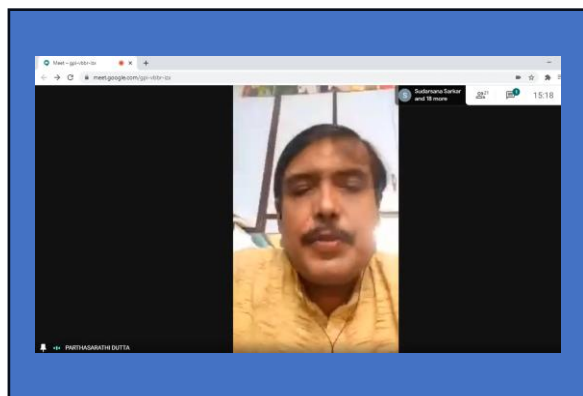

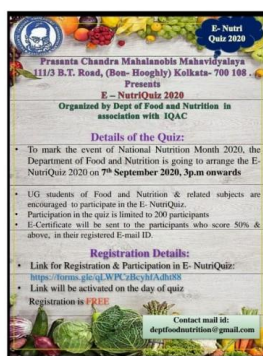


Fig 1: Flyer of E-NutriQuiz 2020

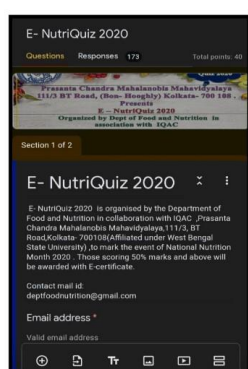


Fig 2: Screenshot of Questionnaire

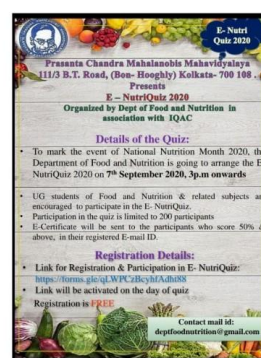


Fig 1: Flyer of E-NutriQuiz 2020

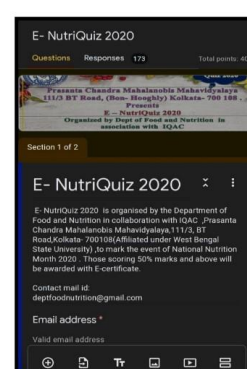
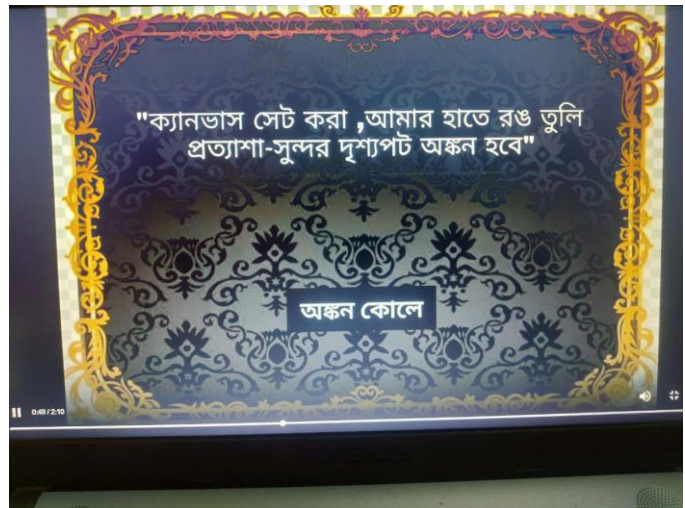
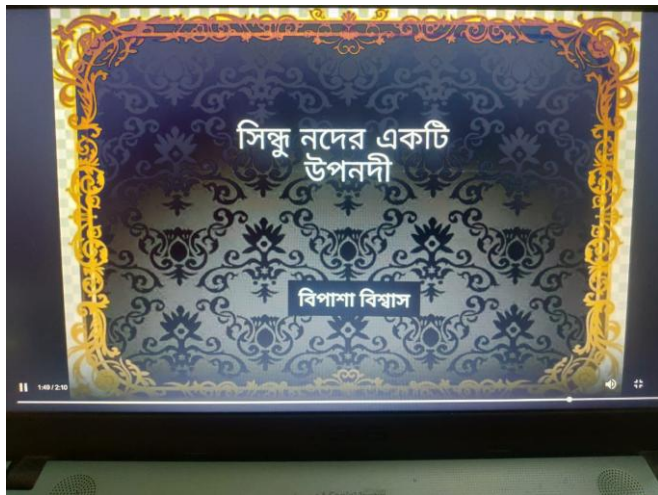
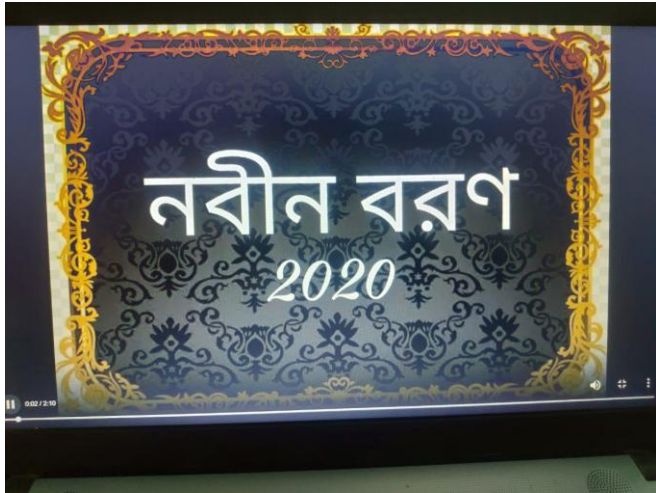


Fig 2: Screenshot of Questionnaire

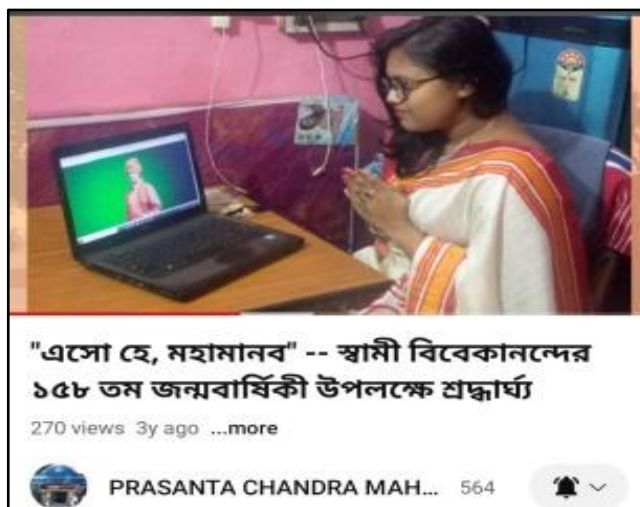
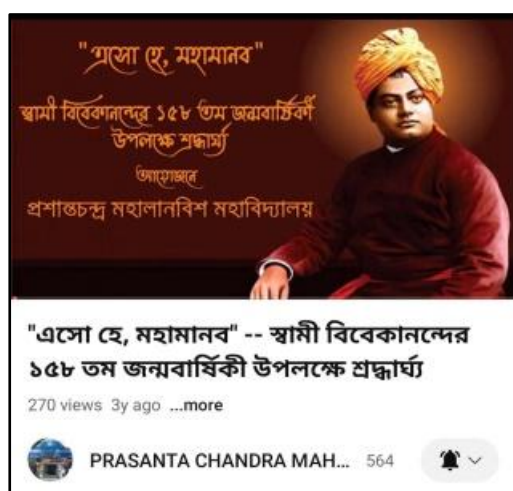
FRESHERS' WELCOME OF SEMESTER-I GEOGRAPHY HONOURS (ONLINE) - 29.09.2020

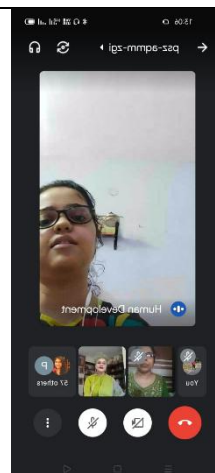

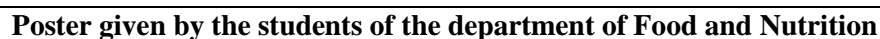


Poster by students of Human Development
