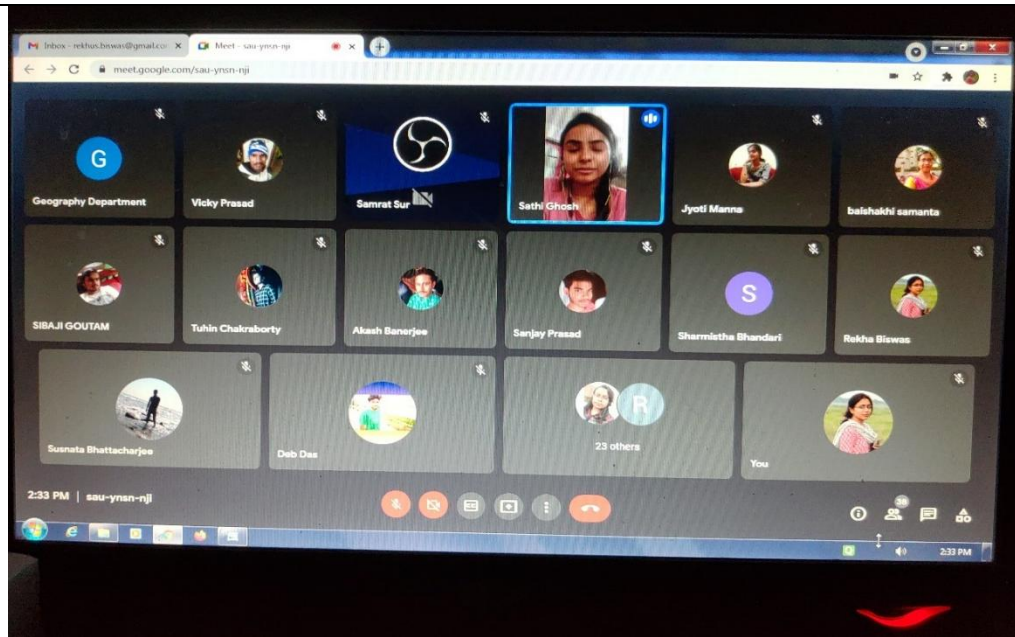

CULTURAL PROGRAMME ON SWADHINATA DIWAS (online)- 15.08.2021

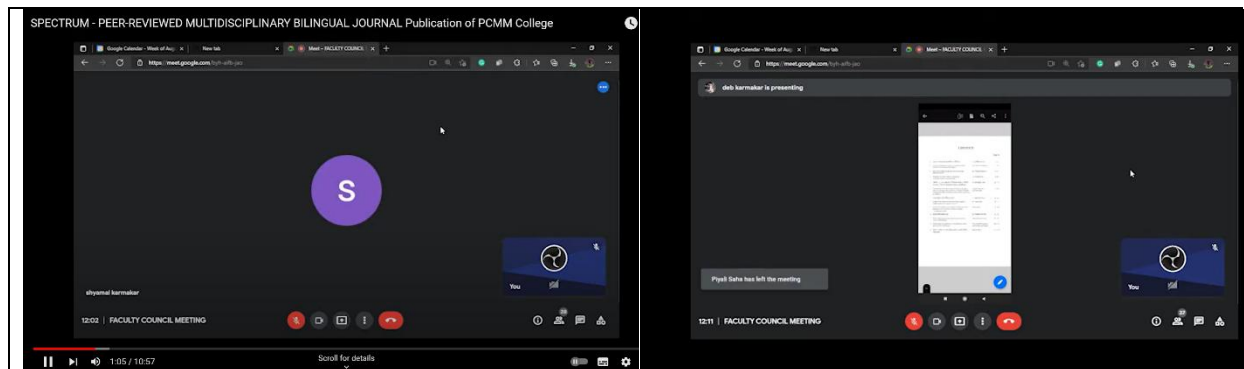

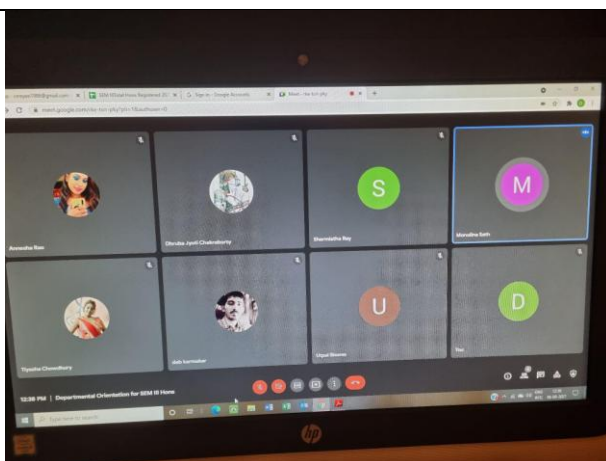

CULTURAL PROGRAMME ON DEPARTMENTAL ORIENTATION DAY (ONLINE)- 08.09.2021

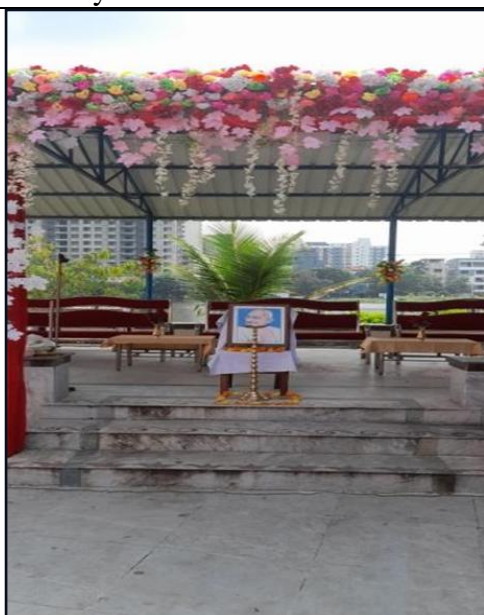

WOMENS' DAY CELEBRATION , CULTURAL EVENT : DRAMA-09.03.2022

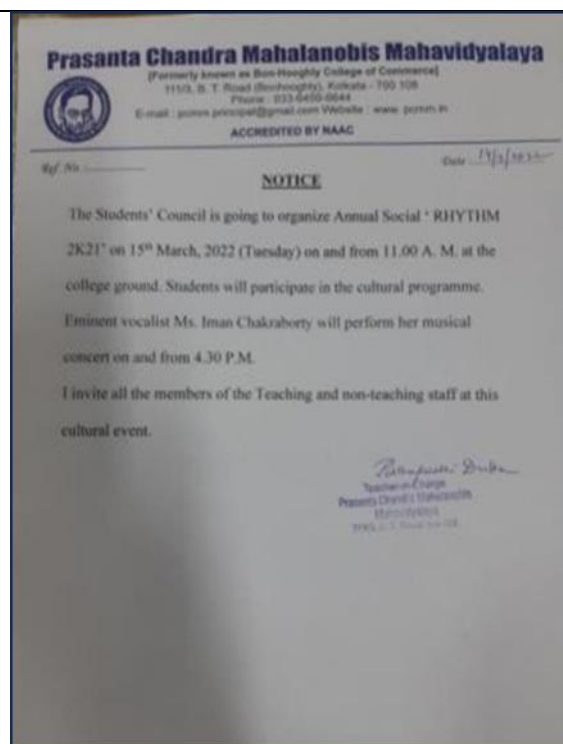

RHYTHM- 2K21: ANNUAL SOCIAL PROGRAMME- 15.03.2022

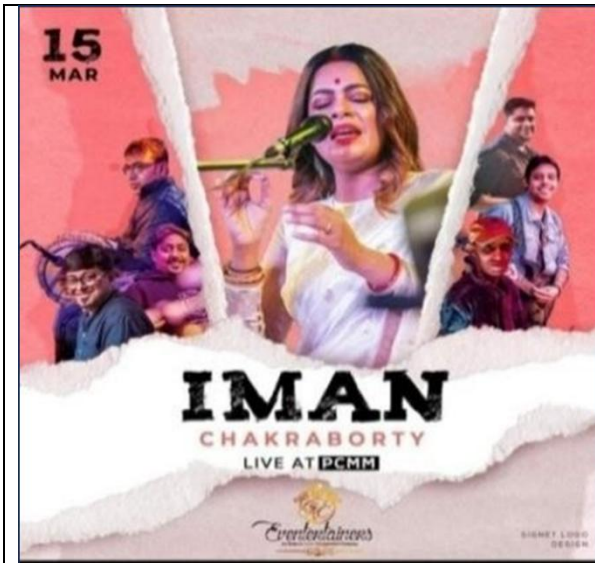

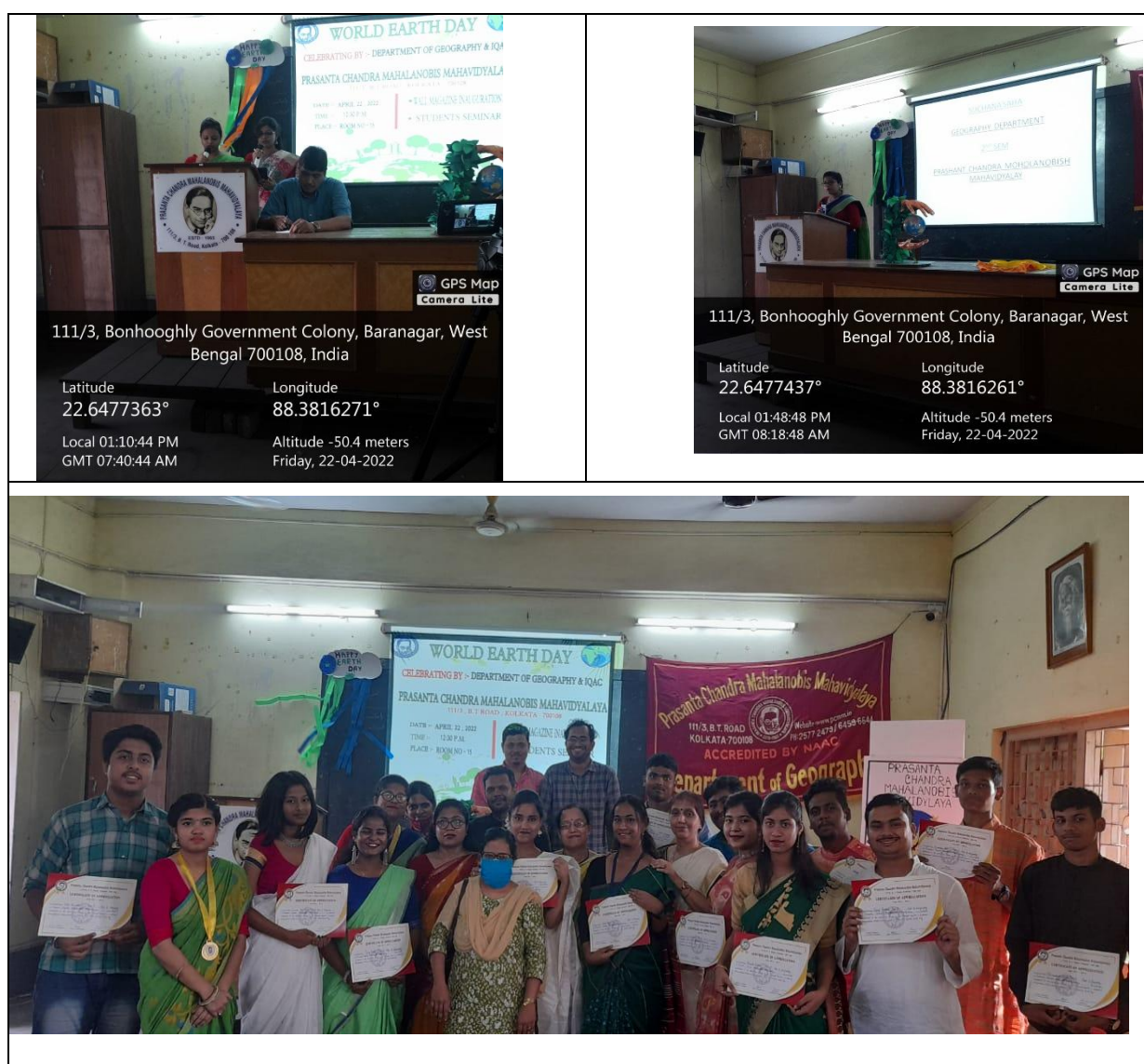

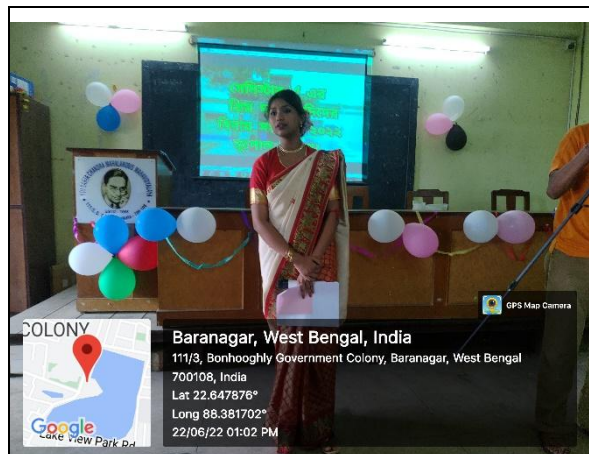
WORLD MUSIC DAY- 21.06.2022
