POSTER COMPETITION AND DEMONSTRATION- 16.08.2022

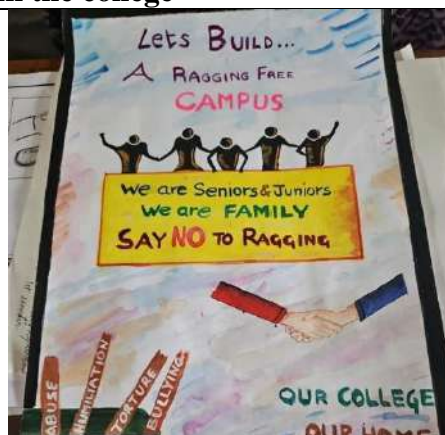

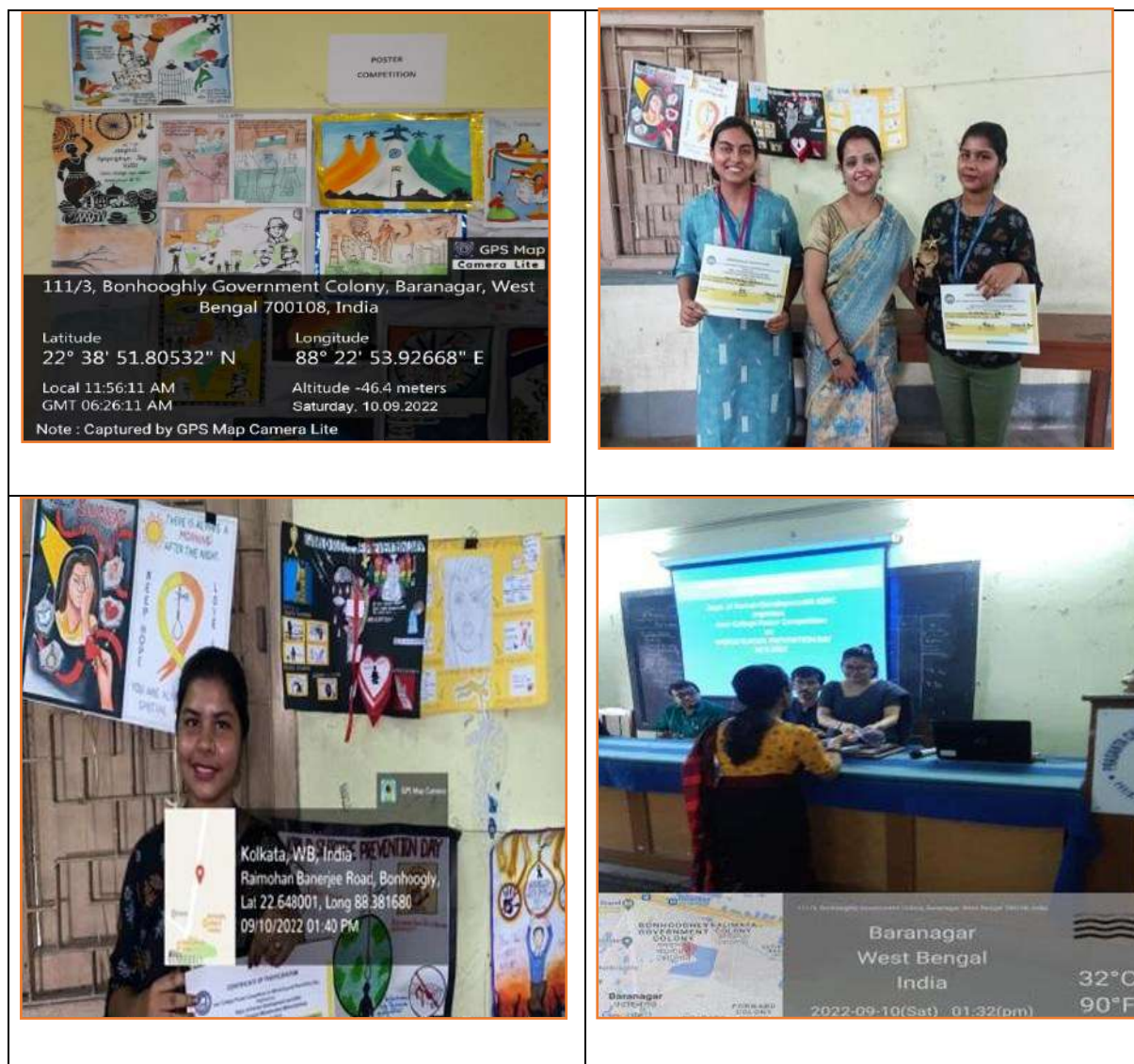
CULTURAL PROGRAMME (GURU PRONAM) - 05.09.22

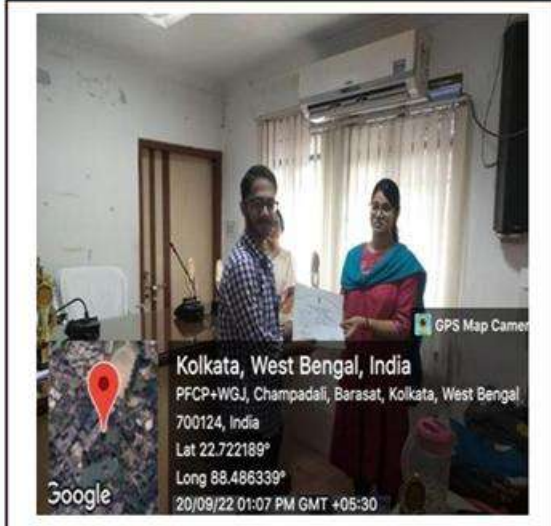
INTER COLLEGE POSTER COMPETITION-10.09.22

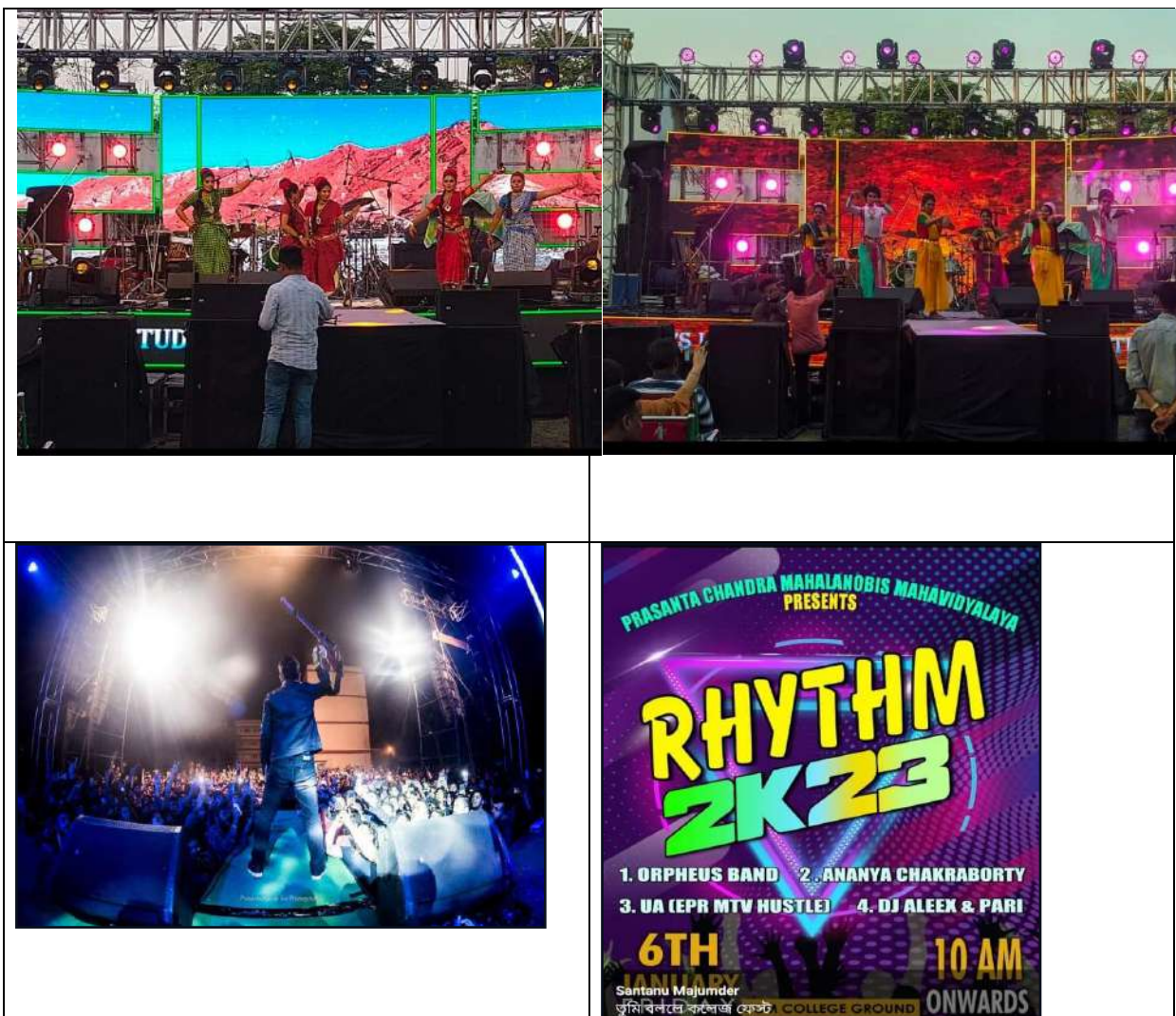
STUDENT SEMINAR CUM POSTER COMPETITION-03.01.2023

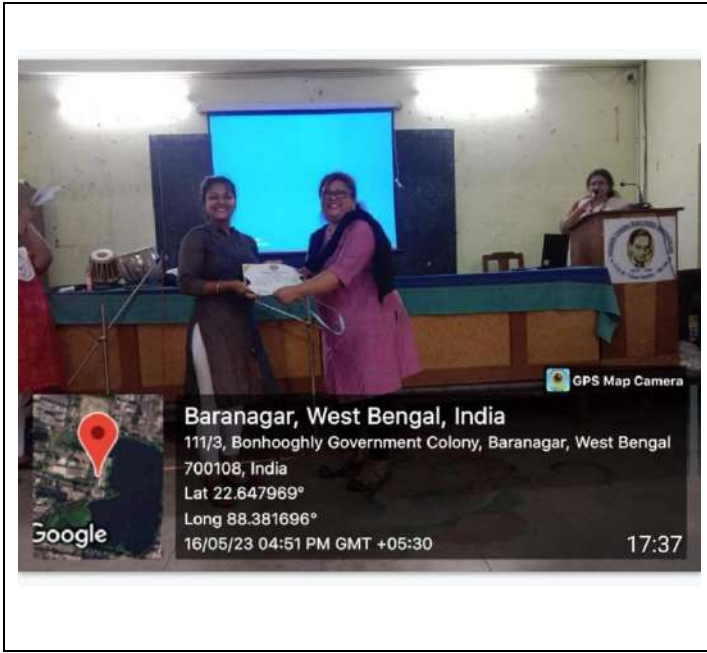

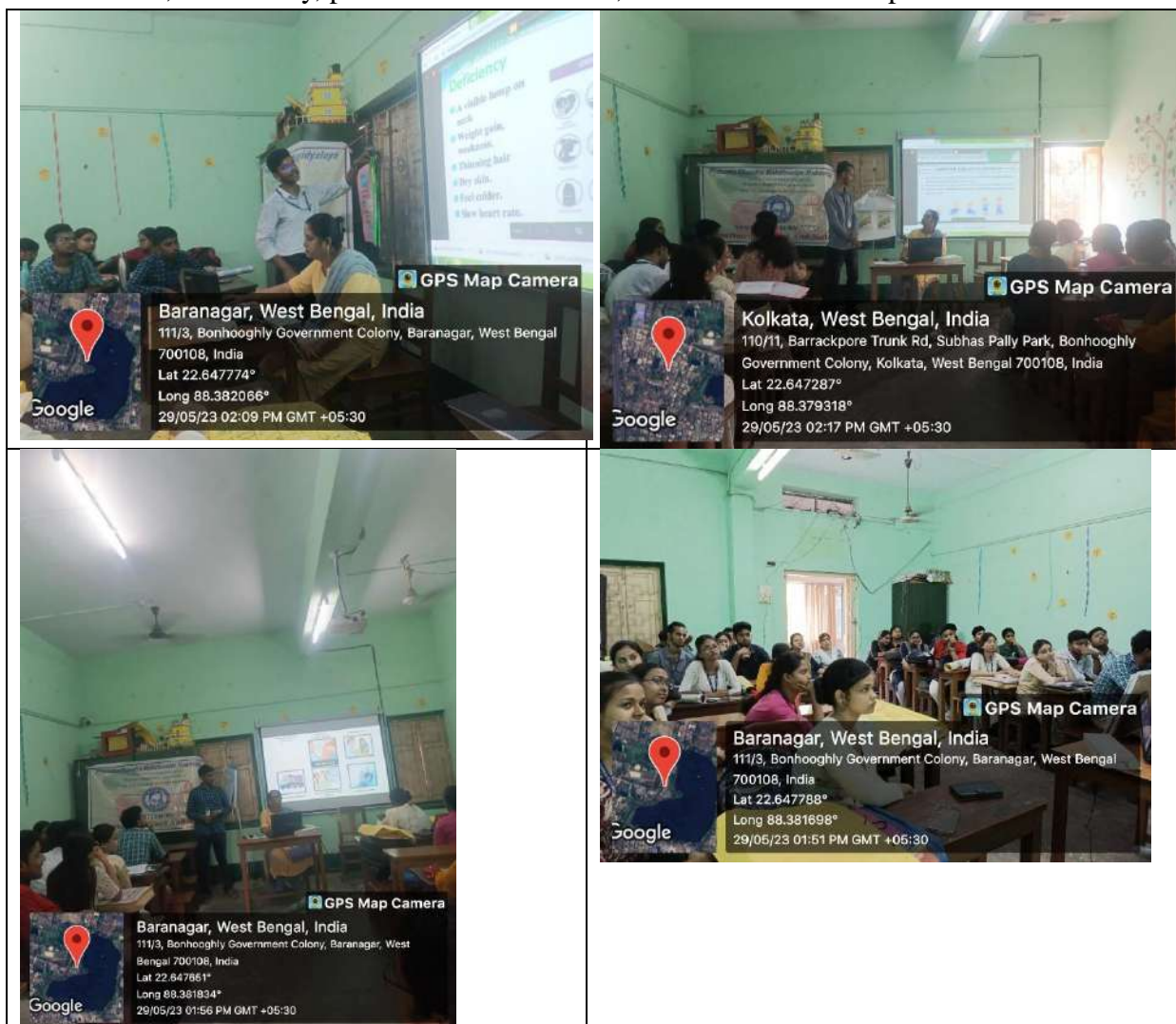
DEPARTMENTAL WALL MAGAZINE ON "MANAB JAGAT" -27.05.2023

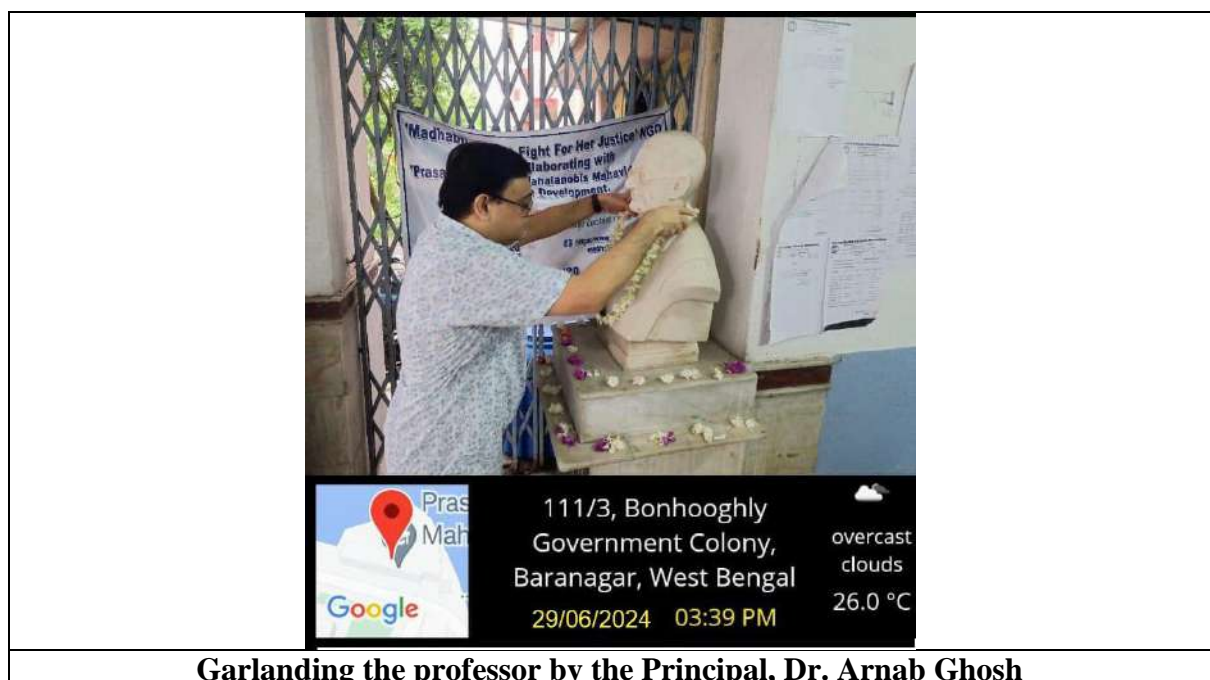
CULTURAL PROGRAMME ON WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY- 03.06.2023
