1. Keeping the campus virus-free.











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

Objective of the event-

Details of the event

The NSS unit of PCMM and the Department of Food and Nutrition visited Shantineer, an old age home located at Subhash Pally, Baranagar on 5th April (Tuesday) 2022. The programme started with a welcome address by Dr Tanima Paul Das, Assistant Professor, Department of Food and Nutrition. In her address she highlighted the objectives of the visit. Beneficiaries of the event-Students


Outcome of the event- The awareness programme has helped the students to know all the medical facts related to thalasaemia as well as the types and severity of this disorder.
