### NSS Activities in the Academic Session 2022-2023

Activity Name: Tree Plantation Drive

Activity Date: 07.06.2022 Venue: PCMM Campus

Objective: The primary objective of the Tree Plantation Drive was to promote environmental sustainability and increase green cover in the city. By planting trees, the NSS aimed to enhance



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biodiversity, combat climate change, and provide cleaner air and a healthier environment for future generations.

### Details of the Event:

The NSS Unit of Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya organized a tree plantation programme to celebrate World Environment Day. This programme was held on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at 1 P.M in our college campus. 72 volunteers and 12 faculty members participated in this Tree Plantation Drive. Activity Date: 14.06.2022 Venue: Janakalyan Samiti

Objective: The workshop focused on spreading awareness about common health issues, preventive measures, and best hygiene practices to promote overall well-being to underprivileged children.

### Details of the Event:

The NSS unit of Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya, Kolkata organized a Health and Hygiene Workshop: স্থান্য (Health is Wealth) at Janakalyan Samiti in collaboration with Madhabilata: The Fight For Her Justice on 14th June 2022. The workshop was conducted by 83 students of the college to spread awareness about Health and Hygiene among underprivileged children. The NSS volunteers also distributed stationery among the underprivileged children. The NSS volunteers were accompanied by two members of the faculty.

### Outcome:

The workshop aimed to introduce participants to various yoga techniques that can help in stress management, enhancing flexibility, and improving overall health.

### Details of the Programme:

The NSS Unit of Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya organized a Yoga Workshop. This programme was held on 21.06.2022. In this programme 75 students and 7 faculty members were participated. Students of our college demonstrated of basic yoga poses such as Tadasana (Mountain Pose), Vrikshasana (Tree Pose), and Adho Mukha Svanasana (Downward-Facing Dog). 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Activity Name: Vaccination Drive

Activity Date: 05.08.2022; 08.08.2022 and 22.08.2022

Venue: PCMM Premises

Objective: The primary objective of the Vaccination Drive was to provide easy access to essential vaccines for students, faculty, and local community members. The initiative aimed to promote public health, increase awareness about the importance of vaccinations, and help prevent the spread of infectious diseases.

Details of the Programme: Vaccination Drive (Extension Activity held on 05.08.2022; 08.08.2022 and 22.08.2022) The NSS Unit of Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya organized a vaccination drive for at-risk members of staff, students, their parents, ex-students and their families and the immediate community. The COVID-19 free vaccination camp was held on 05.08.2022; 08.08.2022 and 22.08.2022. Both Covishield and Covaxin were administered as second dose and booster dose. 50 NSS volunteers participated in this drive.

### Outcome:

- 1. Over 65 individuals were successfully vaccinated, including students, faculty, and community members.
- 2. Participants were educated about the importance of vaccines, leading to increased community awareness and acceptance.





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Activity Name: Distribution of Education Kit

Activity Date: 23.09.2022

Venue: Dakshineswar Ramkrishna Sangha, Adyapith School

Objective: The primary objective of the Educational Kit Distribution initiative was to support and encourage the education of underprivileged students by providing them with essential educational materials. This initiative aimed to reduce the disparity in educational resources and promote learning among students.

### Details of the Programme:

The NSS unit of Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya distributed educational kits consisting of notebooks, pencils, erasers, sharpeners and other stationery items. Volunteers interacted with students, discussing their interests and the importance of education in shaping their future. The workshop aimed to raise awareness about the symptoms, challenges, and care strategies for individuals affected by Alzheimer's, and to promote support for patients and caregivers.

### Details of the Programme:

The NSS unit of Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya organized an Alzheimer's Awareness Workshop on 24.09.2022. 



The centre supervisor helped in arranging the children at 9 am. 25 children along with their mother were present. The students of our department were divided into four groups. Informal study was also being observed by the students which the children very eagerly said. The children also drew pictures in the mean time.
