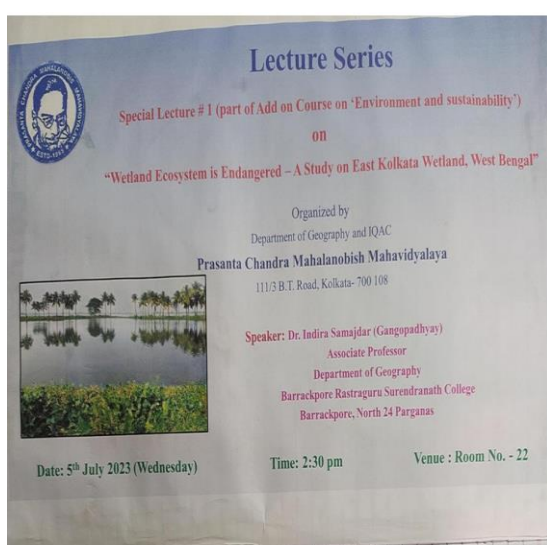

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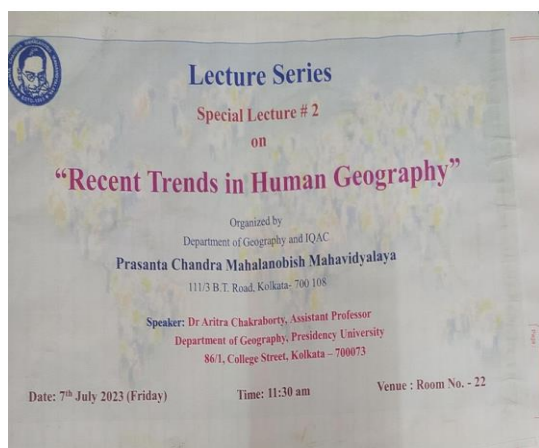

- The importance of human geography..



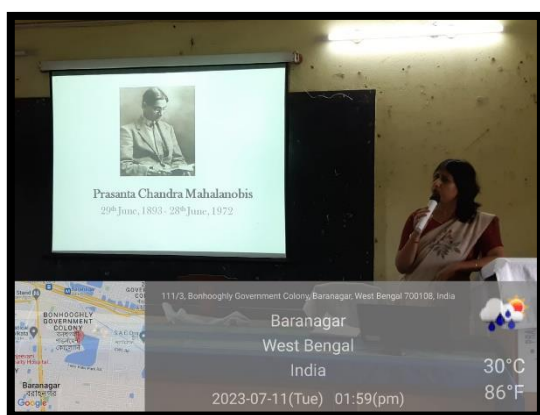

A state level seminar on “A Journey to the Cosmos” organised by Department of Mathematics on 11.07.2023

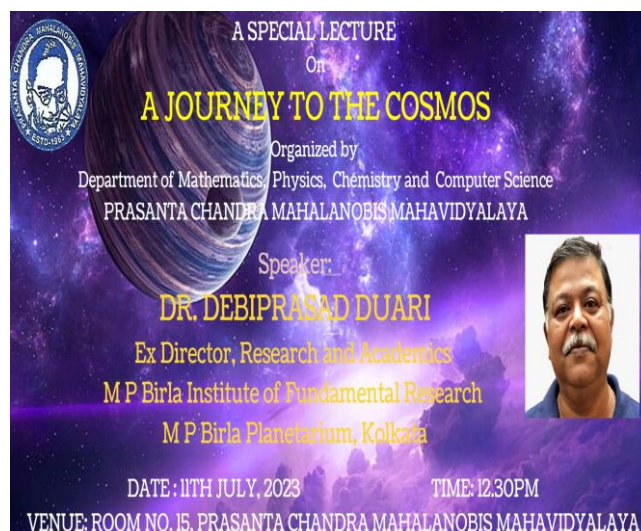

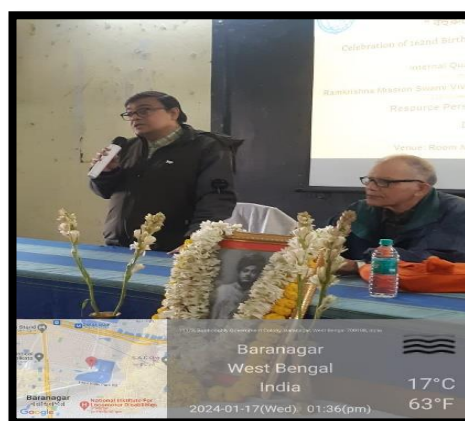
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One day State Level Seminar on Thoughts and Philosophy of Swami Vivekananda on 17.01.2024

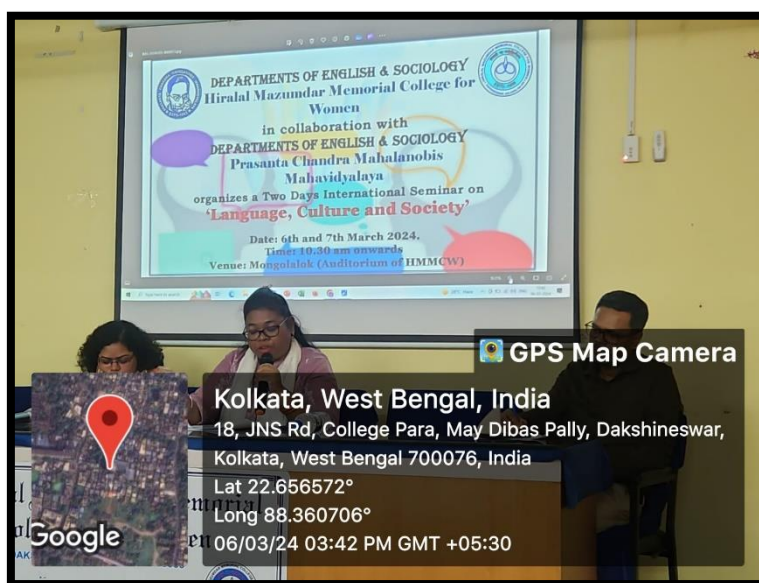

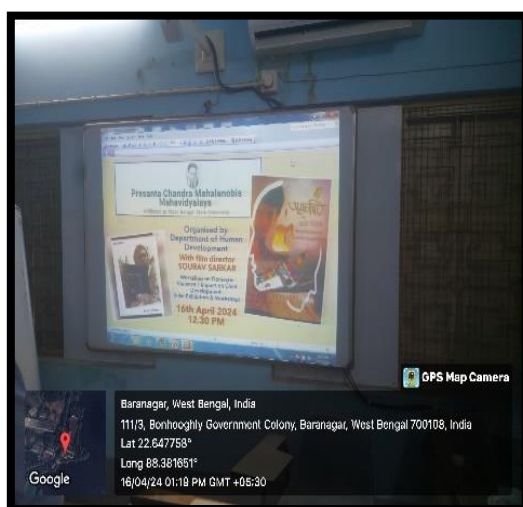

A State Level Seminar on Relevance of Dalit History Month organised by Department of Sociology on 27.04.2024

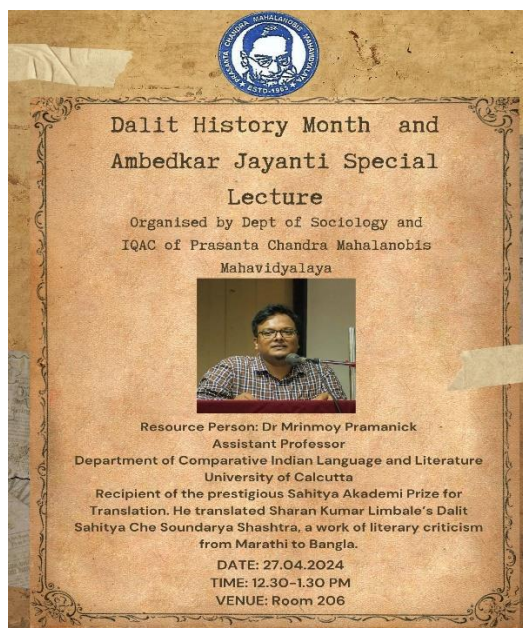

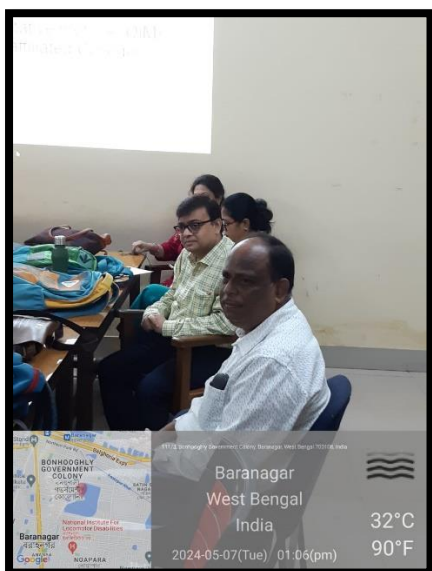

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A State Level Seminar on Preparation of SSR organised by IQAC on 07.05.2024

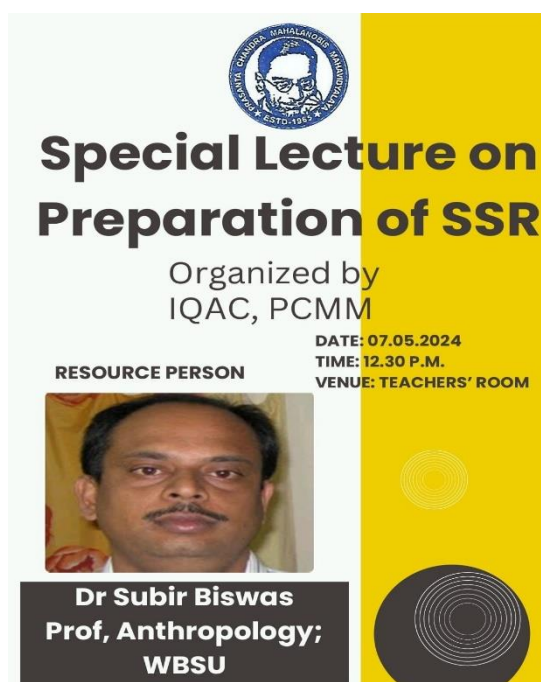
